

RETIREMENT - Master Warrant Officer, GS Laird, CE Supt -0307

1. MWO Scott Laird will retire after completing over 32 years of loyal, dedicated and professional service to the Canadian Forces and Canada.
2. Scott joined the Reserve's on 13 Dec 1975 at St John's NF. He later transferred to the Regular component of the force in Feb 78. During a lengthy career he has served on a number of Base's and Stations within Canada such as CFB Winnipeg, Edmonton, North Bay, Comox and CFS Alert.
